Second Step Middle School (Grades 6-8) Implementation Workshop

Transitioning to middle school can be tough. The research-based *Second Step* program helps schools teach and model essential communication, coping, and decision-making skills that help adolescents navigate around common pitfalls such as peer pressure, substance abuse, and bullying (both in-person and online). The outcomes include reduced aggression and support for a more inclusive environment that helps students stay in school, make good choices, and experience social and academic success.

Students enjoy the interactive activities, video vignettes, and guided discussions of real-world scenarios.
